Listed below are Q & A's that you may have regarding your decision to have your son or daughter try-out for the Turkey Bowl Tournament teams.

What is the Turkey Bowl Tournament, when does it occur and where are the games played?

The Turkey Bowl Tournament consists of 16 area teams playing in a structured divisional tournament. The tournament takes place Thanksgiving weekend (Friday night through Sunday afternoon, times vary). All of the games are played at the Parkwood Youth Organization Fields. (Mechanicville Rd & Dunks Ferry Rd, Northeast Philadelphia, PA)

What is the age requirement?

All boys and girls from our minors program who are born between 8/1/2001 and 7/31/2002 are eligible to try-out.

Why are there try-outs?

There is currently about 100 boys and girls who meet the age requirement. We have no idea how many of these players will try-out. The Fox Chase Soccer Club is one of the few clubs that field two (2) teams in the tournament. Each team will consist of approximately 14 players. Unfortunately, it appears that some players will not make the teams. Some parents do not wish to expose their child to this feeling at this age. This is a decision that you, as a parent, have to think about ahead of time.

When are the try-outs?

Try-outs are scheduled for Saturday, November 8th, and Sunday, November 9th, after all home league games. Depending on the amount of players that try-out and the weather, the coaches may need one additional weekend.

How much time/commitment is involved?

After the home league season is over, the coaches will probably want to practice about 3 to 4 times to get the kids ready for the tournament. Each team is guaranteed 3 games, but depending on the success of the team, teams could play up to 6 games.
