A Message from the Fox Chase Advisory Council

Are you concerned about your child's use of alcohol and other drugs? With the alarming number of teenagers and young adults addicted to drugs in our community, it is our wish to make you better informed of this serious and immediate concern to the youth in the Fox Chase Community. Whether they hang out at the center or in the neighboring community, drugs are very much available to them – prescription drugs like percocet, oxycotin, and others.

Drug use and the addiction may be prevented if you are aware and pro active regarding drugs and alcohol. We, at the center are concerned and want to keep you informed of these dangers. We hope you will talk often to your children, check out their companions, visit their local hang outs and speak more often about the use of drugs.

Some of the evidence is hidden—you don't usually see it or smell it – the child or young adult doesn't come home late- seems pretty normal but he/she could still be taking drugs. If someone tells you that there are drugs being used by friends of your children or young people at the Rec. Center, **BELIEVE THEM AND TAKE THE PROPER ACTION.**
